



Activity Group is a play-based program that allows children to develop social skills and independence and manage separation from parents, sometimes for the first time.

The program is based on the strengths and interests of each child and flows on each week based on the relationships we develop with children, conversations and observations.

The children learn so much from attending Activity Group in the year prior to starting Kinder.

## The children:

- Learn how to take turns in their play.
- Begin to understand they are part of a community of and can be valued and respected away from their normal cycle of family and friends.
- Make choices in play and develop self-esteem and understanding of self-identity.
- Experience active play and an appreciation for the outdoors.
- Learn to listen to stories as a group and be involved in dramatic, music and movement experiences.

The children settle quickly when commencing Activity Group and soon look forward to coming to Kinder each week with their new friends and educators.
